- O Attend/host community events, ask questions, and raise issues
- O Participate in health reform implementation activities
- O Develop/maximize medical respite care and PSH programs
- Ensure outreach and enrollment funding/initiatives
- O Participate in local delivery of care reform discussions (ACOs, CCEs, etc.)
- O Coordinate advocacy agenda with local/state coalitions
- Educate policymakers about needs of homeless populations
- Teach/lecture/recruit at area professional schools to develop poverty-informed workforce
- O Use traditional & social media to highlight success stories and key issues
