

Explicitly defined link between the patient and the provider care team







Population Management

Goal: Assure that EVERY patient receives optimal care

- ✓ Address preventive, chronic and acute needs of All patients (those that come in for care and those that don't)
- Establish continuity of care between patients and assigned care team
- Manage supply and demand so patients can reliably see their assigned provider.



WHY? Because Continuity of Care...

- increases efficiency
- increases quality
- decreases errors, promotes safety
- decreases redundancy
- increases patient, staff, provider satisfaction
- enables patient-centered care and patient selfmanagement support
- Is basic premise of population management



What is needed?

- Strong effective leadership to drive the process
- Change in practice responsibilities and workflow (team based care)
- Move from reactive to proactive care
- Planned care of population requires ability to generate data/lists
- Technology is tool to support process





I. Engaged Leadership

- Establish and support paradigm shift to empanelment
- Develop policy for PCP assignments: initial assignments, transfers, transitioning care
- Integrate Policy of empanelment into practice: job descriptions, new hire orientation, communications with patients
- Ensure staff have resources to support empanelment (HIT).
