

| Type of Mental Disorder | % Adults |
|---------------------------|----------|
| Anxiety disorder | 18.1 |
| Major depressive disorder | 6.7 |
| Substance use disorder | 3.8 |
| Bipolar disorder | 2.6 |
| Eating disorders | 2.1 |
| Schizophrenia | 1.1 |
| Any mental disorder | 26.2 |

US adults with an anxiety disorder in any one year

| Specific phobia | 8.7% | |
|--------------------------------|------|-----|
| Social phobia | 6.8% | |
| Post-traumatic stress disorder | 3.5% | /o |
| Generalized anxiety disorder | 3.1 | 0/0 |
| Panic disorder | 2.7 | 0/0 |
| Obsessive-compulsive disorder | 1. | .0% |
| Agoraphobia (without panic) | 0. | .8% |
| Any anxiety disorder | 18. | 1% |

What is a Mental Health Crisis?

Examples of Mental Health Crises

- suicidal thoughts and behaviors
- nonsuicidal self-injury
- panic attacks
- traumatic events affecting adults
- traumatic events affecting children
- acute psychosis
- medical emergency from alcohol use
- aggressive behavior

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Assess for risk of suicide or harm
Listen nonjudgmentally
Give reassurance and information
Encourage appropriate professional help
Encourage self-help and other support strategies
