...going to the park. You know, you go out there and it's real calming, relaxing. You don't have to be a child to get on the swing. It's the **small things**. Maybe it has to do with who you socialize with... the people you hang out with them...they impact what you do and what risks you take.



“Need Help”

That lady over there is old. She's sleeping in the street and sometimes she go to McDonalds. If you making money, why are you staying in the street?
So many people **need help** but wanna stay sleeping in the street...

“All in this Together”

...it made me think we're **all in this together**...that no matter who you are, where you come from, this is a community. I'm not from here, I haven't been here very long and Miami does seem really big but, I...I kinda sense community here as well.

It's about, supporting your community, that it's not just an isolated problem, like if my neighbor is struggling, then that problem is my problem.
