

## Benefits of Organizational Membership

Discounts and donations	Council members are eligible to participate in group purchasing plans through Commonwealth Purchasing Group, access medicine donations via AmeriCares, and receive product donations from our national corporate partners.
Invitation-only meetings	Members are invited to attend the Governing Membership Meeting each May in conjunction with the National Health Care for the Homeless Conference & Policy Symposium, as well as the Governing Membership Fall Summit every October for peer support, networking, and planning.
Members-only journal access	Members receive a free subscription to Health Affairs, a leading peer-reviewed journal of health policy thought and research. Health Affairs explores health policy issues in domestic and international spheres, providing a high-level, nonpartisan forum to promote analysis and discussion on improving health and health care and addressing such issues as cost, quality, and access. Subscriptions start at \$551 per year; organizational members receive free access.
Recognition	Members receive a certificate of membership and the "Proud Member of the National HCH Council" button for display on a website.
Committee participation	Members are eligible to participate in some Council Steering Committees and the Governing Membership. Other committees and networks are open to all. Committee members compare notes with colleagues, contribute to the development of a national agenda, serve as expert resources on practice issues, participate in multi-site research projects, and advocate for improved public policies.
