



Charge to the Education Committee

The Education Committee of the National Health Care for the Homeless Council is a Standing Committee of the Board of Directors.

The Chairperson will be appointed annually by the President of the Board, will take office on July 1 of each year, and will serve as a member of the Board of Directors and of the Governing Membership. The President shall appoint the Vice Chair in consultation with the Chair.

Other members of the Committee will be volunteers and will include members interested in planning and shaping the technical assistance and training program of the Council, including administrators, clinicians, and consumers.

The Committee will meet monthly via conference call. The National HCH Council will staff the Committee.

The Committee is charged to:

- Review and address the Training and Technical Assistance needs of programs that provide health care and related services to persons experiencing homelessness in concert with the work of other standing committees of the Board and the steering committees of the individual membership groups;
- Contribute to the setting of priorities prior to the issuance of the Call for Abstracts for the National HCH Conference and serve on proposal review committees;
- Review the Council deliverables under the Cooperative Agreement with HRSA that address topics of relevance to member agencies and others providing health care and related services to persons experiencing homelessness, with special attention to the work of the Technical Assistance and Training program, including, but not limited to, the national conference and regional trainings, webinars, targeted trainings, and online courses;
- Review evaluations of the technical assistance and training program to inform the committee's recommendations for future deliverables;
- Work to include consumers in the planning and delivery of Technical Assistance and Training.
