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Role of HCH in integrated trauma informed care teams

- Integrated care teams can help tease out role of traumatic brain injuries vs. additions vs. mental illness vs. trauma (Quad-morbid)
- Teams should be include peer providers, mental health professionals, addiction treatment counselors, nurses and access to a housing specialist, employment specialist and benefits specialist
- Services need to be provided flexibly in the community, on the street, in homes, in the hospital, at odd hours and wherever the patient is.
- Trauma informed requires a non-judgmental approach, compassion, understanding that their past traumatic experiences are driving their behaviors.
- The Patient Centered Primary Care team has to be available to the integrated trauma informed care team.
- Must utilize a patient centered care plan that is driven by the compatient.

Mandate for leaders into the future

- Identify flexible funding streams to support best practice trauma informed integrated care teams:
 - Hospital charitable care and flexible funds
 - Managed Care/ Coordinated Care Organization flexible funds
 - 1115 Waivers and other CMS Waivers
 - State SAMHSA CMHS and CSAT Block Grant
 - HUD voucher programs- Work with local Housing Authority
