Conditions of Residency Occupancy Agreement

Welcome to Interfaith House! This is a brief summary of the conditions for residency at Interfaith House. These conditions help us to have a community of care among our residents and staff. During your Orientation Period (which usually takes 7 days to complete) an orientation session will be offered which will explain the house program in greater detail.

- Alcohol and illegal drugs interfere with treatment, so the possession or use of alcohol and drugs is not allowed while you are a resident. To keep the house drug and alcohol free, regular drug tests will be administered.
- 2. For the health of residents and staff, cigarette smoking is only allowed during free time either in the smoking lounge or the outside patio area; smoking anywhere else inside the facility is prohibited.
- Upon admission, we ask you to shower and put on clean clothes to help us promote a healthy
 environment in our respite center, we will also wash and dry any clothing that you have brought
 in with you.
- 4. In order to meet with a member of the health services team, your assigned case manager, and to receive an Interfaith House orientation, you are required to remain in the building (excluding medical and other social service appointments), until you have completed the orientation period.
- 5. Since room, board, clothing, and travel are provided, residents are asked to save 75% of any income, including any government assistance that they earn during their stay. Exceptions can be made with your case manager for any necessary expenses.
- Sexual Activity is prohibited on the premises.
- 7. To maintain a community of care and respect, violence, threats, verbal harassment, and crude language are not allowed.

I understand the above conditions, while ongoing, will be reviewed after 30 days at which time staff along with yourself will discuss your need for further services in our program. By signing below I accept and agree to follow these conditions of residency at Interfaith House:
